

I was a little bit disappointed, much of this I had figured out by trial and error, but I did pick up some new information that will help refine my technique and should improve my paint handling. I like the authors works illustrated in the book and it's nice to get his explanation of the techniques he used while painting. There are several step by step paintings in that back of the book for some very nice pictures and will provide a great start for the budding realism painter. A very good introduction or review of the essentials

Many modern painters seem to have abandoned realism for more abstract or impressionistic forms of art, but that is clearly not the case for the author of this book. Mark Weber freely shares the methods he uses to produce the remarkably beautiful and highly detailed landscapes, portraits, still lifes and other scenes illustrated in this book. His material is presented clearly and includes the seemingly-requisite step-by-step paintings typical for introductory books. Most or all of the information on brush selection and use could probably be gleaned by reading other books for the beginning or intermediate painter, but the clear way it is put together makes this an excellent choice for the beginning painter and for intermediate oil painters aspiring towards realism. Weber works in water soluble oils. Painters working in acrylics (as I do) can also apply most of these techniques as long as they understand that some methods don't apply (e.g., varishes, solvents) and others need to be adapted to work with faster drying paints. For a relatively new painter who doesn't have a lot of books on painting already, this would be a very good choice for one of their first few books, as it would for intermediate painters looking for ideas on how to achieve other effects.
