

Over the Fence is a sweet and moving love story that I didn't want to end. I adored the characters and the unique and heart-felt story line. The main characters are solitary beings who are lonely, broken, and internally and externally scarred by their own families. Kourtney – with a K, experienced a childhood of neglect and physical and emotional abuse, and although timid and insecure, she somehow managed to maintain a kind and thoughtful soul. Nathan also had a painful past, and although we are to be tantalized by the knowledge that he is tortured by his regrets, we not given the full accounting of what his past actually entailed until late in the book.
